

## READ A BOOK A MONTH CHALLENGE

### **Book Review:** Gulliver's Travels – Voyage I & Voyage II

Gulliver's Travels by Jonathan Swift is an adventurous and imaginative novel that cleverly combines fantasy with satire. Through the strange lands Gulliver visits, Swift holds up a mirror to human behaviour, exposing our pride, foolishness, and the way we judge others.

### **Voyage I – The Land of Lilliput**

The first voyage takes Gulliver to Lilliput, a land of tiny people who are only six inches tall. Although they are small in size, their problems and arguments are surprisingly big. Swift uses their silly quarrels—like fighting over which end of an egg to break—to criticize how humans often argue over meaningless issues. Gulliver's mixed experiences with the Lilliputians show how pride, jealousy, and politics can easily damage relationships. This voyage is both humorous and thought-provoking.

### **Voyage II – The Land of Brobdingnag**

In the second voyage, the situation is reversed. Gulliver becomes the tiny one in the land of giants, Brobdingnag. The gentle giant girl Glumdalclitch, and the King treat him with kindness and curiosity. Through his conversations with the giant King, Swift highlights how human achievements, wars, and politics look foolish when viewed from a different perspective. This voyage teaches humility and offers a fresh way of understanding human behaviour.

### **Overall Impression**

Both voyages mix fun, fantasy, and sharp observations about society. Swift's ability to use imaginary lands to reveal real human weaknesses makes the book enjoyable for young readers and meaningful for adults. Voyage I teaches us not to let trivial matters become major conflicts, while Voyage II encourages us to look at ourselves from another angle. Together, they make Gulliver's Travels an entertaining and timeless classic.
