# EDITORIAL

Empower women. Secure water. Transform the world!

## WOMEN AND WATER

Women bear the disproportionate burden of the global water crisis, as they are primarily responsible for collecting water and managing water, tasks that consume billions of hours annually, drives "Time poverty," and reinforce gender inequality. In 80% of households with water shortages, women and girls are responsible for water collection. This isn't just a physical chore; it's a systemic barrier to equality.

### EDUCATIONAL STUNTING:

Many girls in some villages still drop out of school because they spend up to six hours a day trekking for water.

Economic Impact: The hours spent walking could be spent in paid labor, vocational training, or community leadership.

### THE PARADOX OF MANAGEMENT:

Despite being the primary managers of domestic water, women are frequently excluded from the governance of water. When local water committees are formed to manage new wells or irrigation systems, they are often dominated by men. This leads to a disconnect: the people who know the most about the water's quality, and seasonal fluctuations are the ones excluded. To fix the water crisis, we must first fix the seat at the table. You cannot manage a resource effectively if you ignore the primary users.

### THE RIPPLE EFFECT

When we invest in accessible water, the first person to benefit is the woman—and by extension, her entire community.
