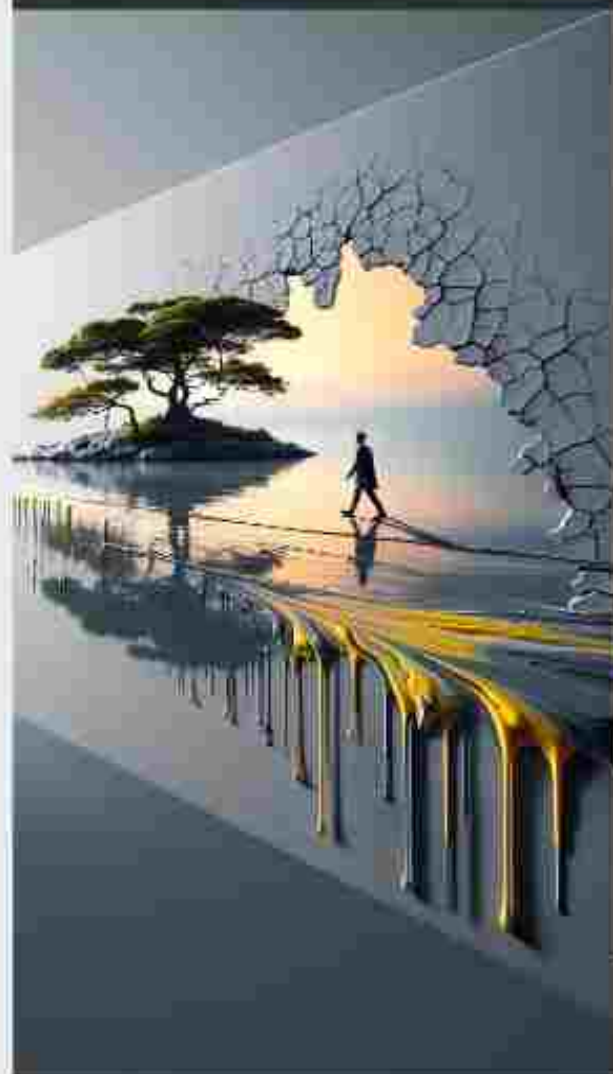

And taught us what wisdom can help us do.

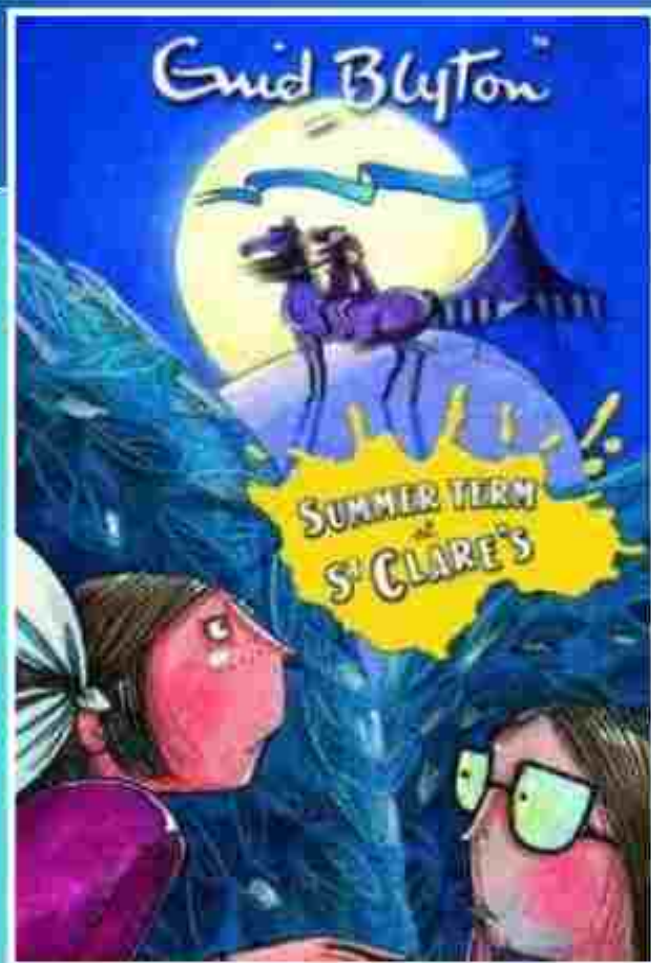

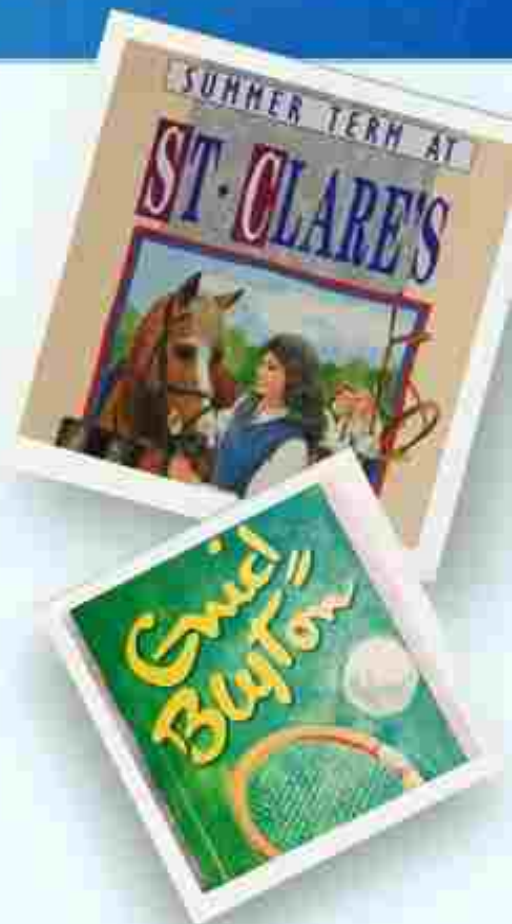


Summer Term at St. Clare's
